




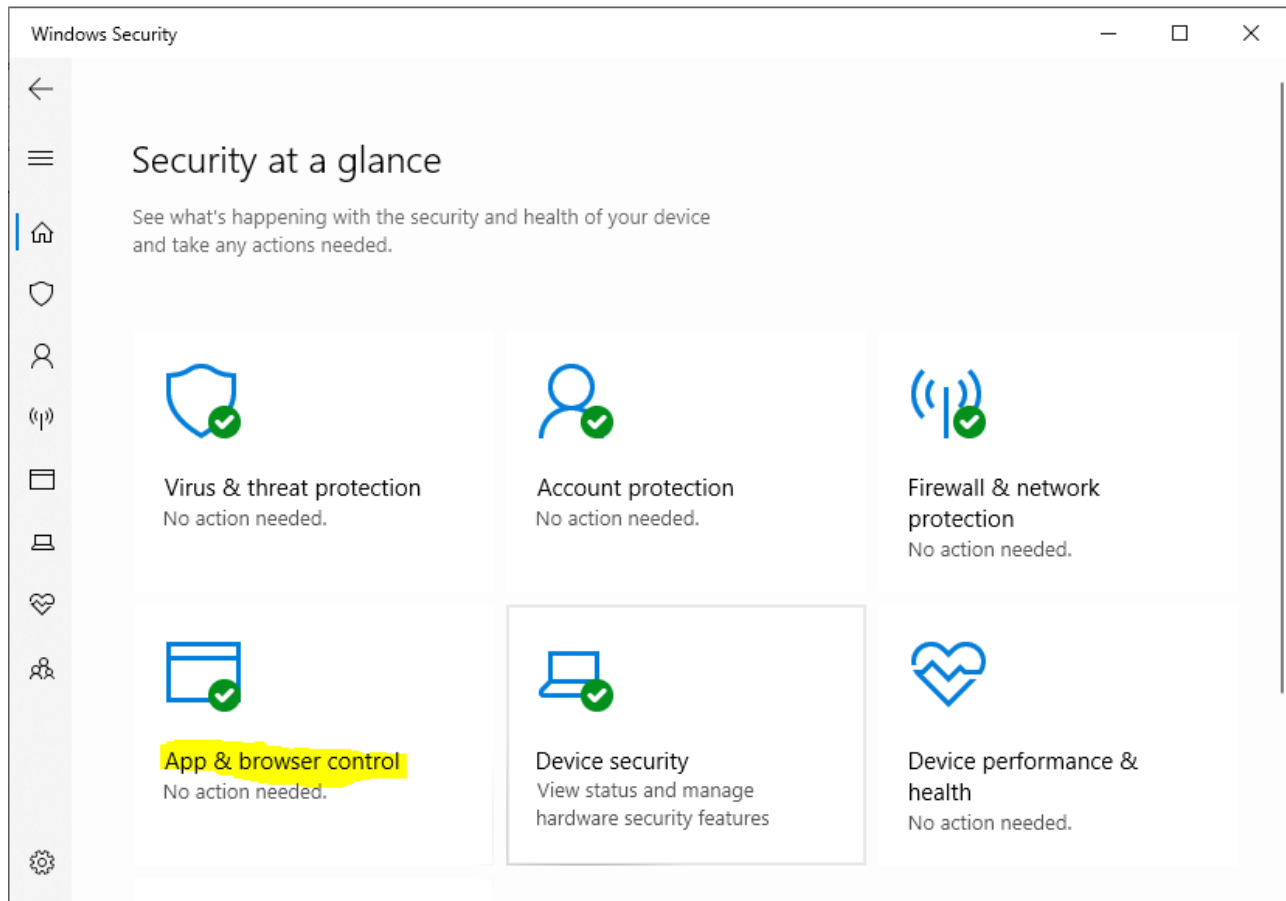
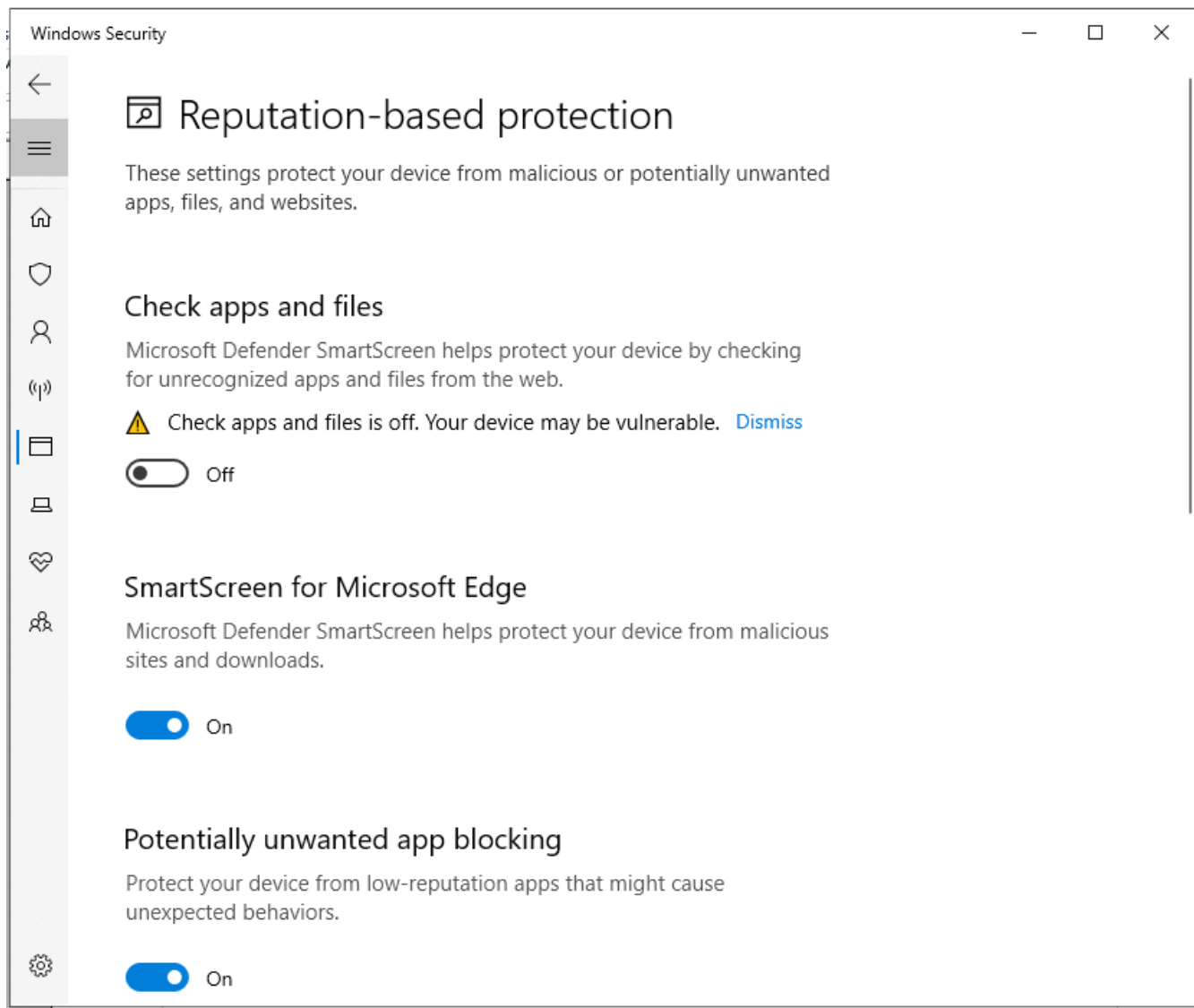


## How to Temporarily Disable Windows Defender SmartScreen to Install *BarrelTime*

- 1) If you are running a 3<sup>rd</sup> party anti-virus software such as Norton, McAfee, etc., the first step is to temporarily disable the 3<sup>rd</sup> party software; Windows Defender (now also known as Microsoft Defender) shuts itself off when a 3<sup>rd</sup> party anti-virus is active, but the Windows Security options are not disabled.
  1. Typically the 3<sup>rd</sup> Party anti-virus announces that it is active with an icon near the clock in the lower right hand corner, something like:  Right click on that icon to display options, including disable/enable options. Un-check the enabling option.
  2. When the 3<sup>rd</sup> party anti-virus is disabled the icon typically becomes disable: 
- 2) Press the Windows Key  or Click on the Start Menu Icon .
- 3) Scroll down the Application List to the Windows Security Icon  near the bottom of the list. Double click.
- 4) Double Click the “App & browser control” icon:

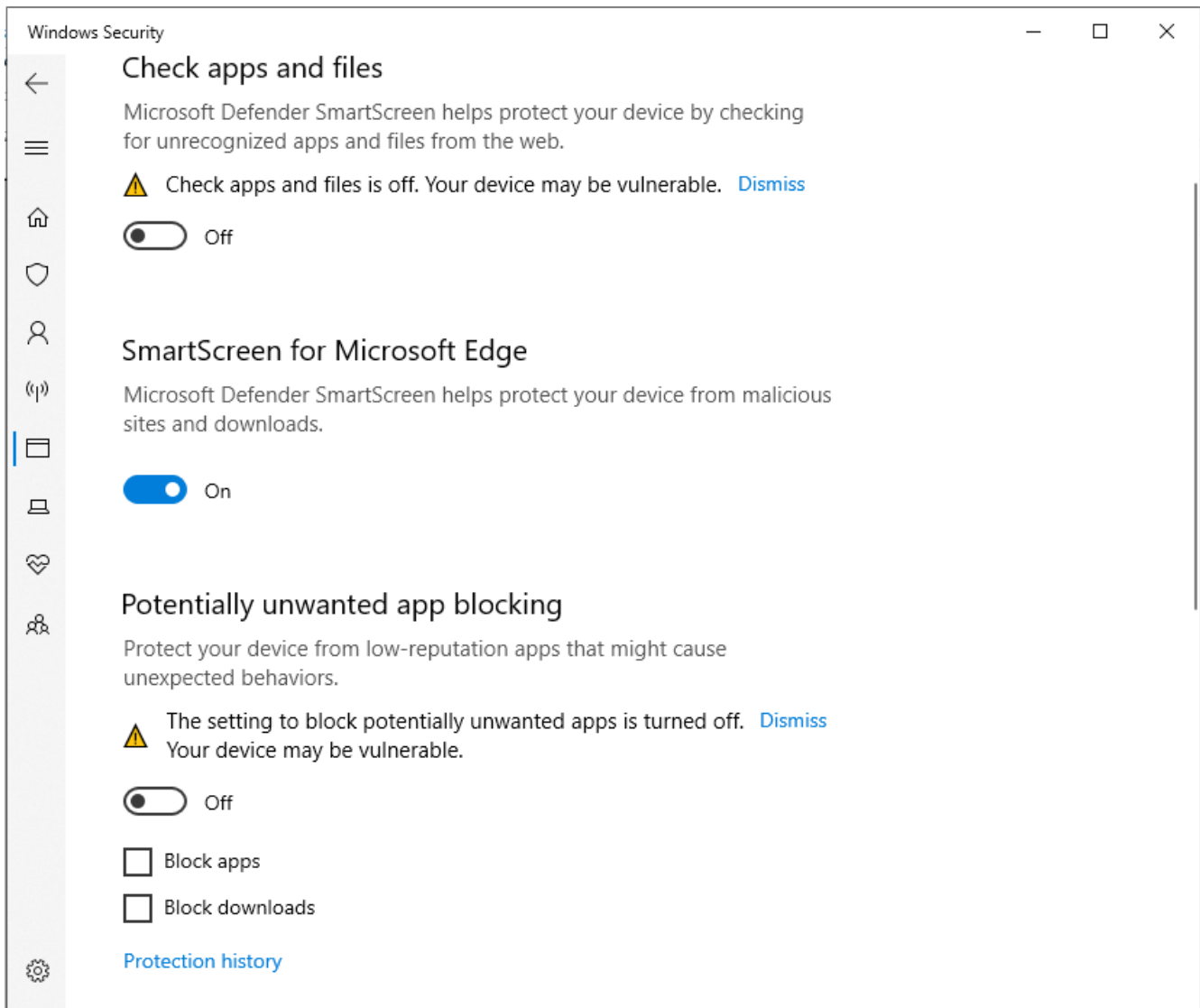


5) Turn off the “Check apps and files” option:



6) If you are using Microsoft Edge – disable SmartScreen for Microsoft Edge.

## 7) Disable “Potentially unwanted app blocking:”



- 8) The SmartScreen Security options that are blocking the **BarrelTime** download/installer have been disabled. Return to the [BarrelTime Downloads](#) page.
- 9) **Don't forget** – after **BarrelTime** has been installed – Re-activate these Microsoft Defender Options.
